<p><b>Invitation Fellowship (Long Term)</b> offers the opportunity for mid career to Professorial level researchers to participate in cooperative research activities for between 61 days to 10 months.</p>	<p>JSPS Tokyo office: Expected Sep. 2015</p>
<p><b>Invitation Fellowship (Short Term)</b> is for established researchers to participate in discussions, attend seminars, give lectures or conduct similar research activities for between 14 to 60 days.</p>	<p>JSPS Tokyo Office: 28 April to 8 May 2015</p>
<p><b>Invitation Fellowship (S)</b> supports researchers with eminent records of research achievements to offer advice and cooperate in research activities with a host institution in Japan for a period of 7 to 30 days.</p>	<p>JSPS Tokyo Office: 28 April to 8 May 2015</p>
