JSPS Standard Award

This fellowship provides the opportunity for Post Doctoral researchers to conduct colloborative research for 12 to 24 months at universities and institutions in Japan.

Eligibility:

Candidates must hold a PhD at the time of starting their fellowship or have obtained their PhD within the last 6 years of applying to go to Japan.

Fellowships must be taken up between April to the end of November.





A Settling in Allowance of approx. £1,300 (¥200,000)
A Research Grant of up to approx. £10,000 (¥1,500,000) per year for cooperative research-related expenses ("Grant-In-Aid for Scientific Research" applied for separately by the Japanese Host)
A Round Trip Air Ticket

Overseas Accident, Travel and Sickness Insurance

A Monthly Allowance of approx.£2,400 (¥362,000)
