JSPS FELLOWSHIP PROGRAMMES TO JAPAN

JSPS has a number of fellowship programmes for researchers at all stages of their career and in all fields of research including the humanities and social sciences:

Fellowship Programme	Next application period/ deadline
The Summer Programme provides the opportunity for graduate student and pre/postdoctoral researchers for a 2 month visit during the Summer.	British Council Tokyo : Expected Jan. 2015
Post Doctoral Fellowship- (Short-Term) is for pre/post-doctoral researchers to conduct research for a period of 1 to 12 months.	JSPS Tokyo office: 7 to 11 April 2014 JSPS London Office: 2 June 2014
Post Doctoral Fellowship- (Standard Term) allows for post-doctoral researchers to go to Japan for a period of 12 to 24 months.	JSPS Tokyo office: 1 to 9 May 2014 British Academy/ Royal Society: Expected Dec. 2014
Post Doctoral Fellowship- (Pathway to University Positions in Japan) supports post-doctoral researchers for a period of 12 to 24 months leading to full time position in a Japanese University or research institution.	JSPS Tokyo office : Expected Nov. 2014
Invitation Fellowship (Long Term) offers the opportunity for mid career to Professorial level researchers to participate in cooperative research activities for between 61 days to 10 months.	JSPS Tokyo office: Expected Sep. 2014
Invitation Fellowship (Short Term) is for established researchers to participate in discussions, attend seminars, give lectures or conduct similar research activities for between 14 to 60 days.	JSPS Tokyo Office: 1 to 9 May 2014
Invitation Fellowship (S) supports researchers with eminent records of research achievements to offer advice and cooperate in research activities with a host institution in Japan for a period of 7 to 30 days.	JSPS Tokyo Office: 1 to 9 May 2014
