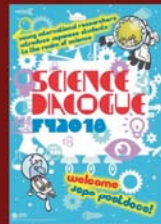




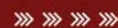

BRIDGE Fellowship Program

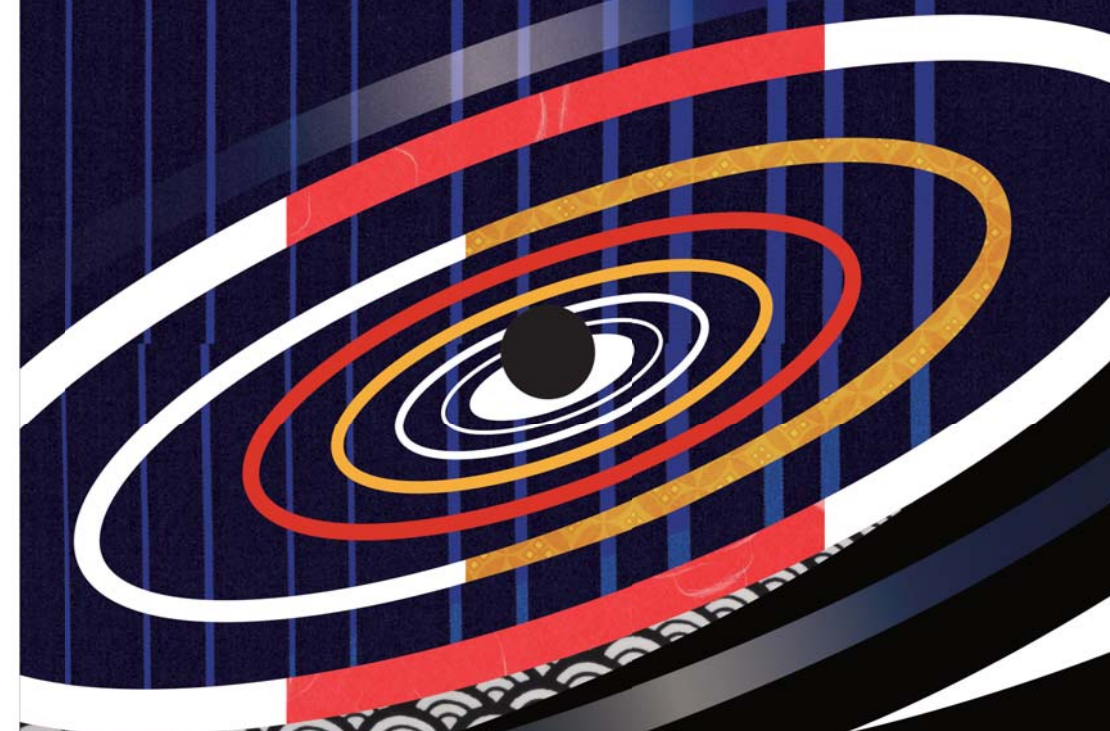
