

JSPS London call of the JSPS Pre/Postdoctoral Fellowship for Research in Japan (Short-term) - Notes for Referees

Written acknowledgement of receipt of reference is not usually given but if required please request this by return e mail.

1. Eligible Referees:

- Referees should be leading international authorities in their chosen field of research.
- The referees should normally and where possible be UK based.
- The applicant's proposed host researcher is **not eligible** to act as a referee.
- At least one reference for PhD students must be provided by their supervisor.

2. Procedure:

- <u>Reference forms should be typed.</u>
- Reference forms for Pre-doctoral applicants <u>must</u> include a statement of the date, month and year the student is expected to submit their final thesis, receive their viva and finally when they can be conferred with their PhD.
- The referee should use the prescribed JSPS London reference form and complete and send it to JSPS London by e mail to <u>short-termaward@jsps.org</u> by the closing date.
