<b>Post Doctoral Fellowship- (Standard Term)</b> allows for post-doctoral researchers to go to Japan for a period of 12 to 24 months.	JSPS Tokyo office: 5 September 2014 British Academy/ Royal Society: Expected Dec. 2014
<b>Post Doctoral Fellowship- (Pathway to University</b> <b>Positions in Japan)</b> supports post-doctoral researchers for a period of 12 to 24 months leading to full time position in a Japanese University or research institution.	<b>JSPS Tokyo office:</b> 5 September 2014
<b>Invitation Fellowship (Long Term)</b> offers the opportunity for mid career to Professorial level researchers to participate in cooperative research activities for between 61 days to 10 months.	<b>JSPS Tokyo office:</b> 5 September 2014
<b>Invitation Fellowship (Short Term)</b> is for established researchers to participate in discussions, attend seminars, give lectures or conduct similar research activities for between 14 to 60 days.	JSPS Tokyo Office: 5 September 2014
<b>Invitation Fellowship (S)</b> supports researchers with eminent records of research achievements to offer advice and cooperate in research activities with a host institution in Japan for a period of 7 to 30 days.
