There are three categories of membership ...

• All persons who have or will receive support from JSPS or STA are eligible for *regular membership*.

Associate membership may be granted to persons who have strong links with Japan.

 Persons who have a distinguished record of promoting scientific exchange between the UK and Japan are eligible for *honorary membership*.

What do we do?

Furusato Award

- Grant to pay travel & subsistence costs for up to 5

- Sister scheme for Japanese researchers based in the UK
 - Phase 2 'follow-on' symposium or seminar
